

This group meets in the *Reformation Room* led by **Don Beavers.**


SEEKERS Class: is studying *Experience Jesus. Really.* by John Eldredge through March 30th.


In today's age, we are all becoming disciples of the Internet. Our weary, skeptical world is keeping us from experiencing the God we are dying without.




