Holy Week

I trust that many of you have found the Lenten Season to be both meaningful and an opportunity for spiritual growth through scripture and prayer. These moments with God are intended to guide us to a place where burdens, joys, fears, and hope intersect in the life of Jesus. Thus, Holy Week is a time when we encounter the God who is for us.

Our schedule for Holy Week will be full, encompassing both solemn and celebratory aspects of worship.







First, on Palm Sunday, April 13th at 10am, our Kids Club and Cherub Choirs will be singing and parading in with palms to celebrate the Entrance of Christ into Jerusalem. The Beginning Handbells group will also be featured.



On **Thursday, April 17**th **at 7pm**, we hold the Maundy Thursday Service full of text, song, and meditations. To fulfill the covenant God made with the people of Israel, God sent his only son, Jesus, Word made flesh, to walk upon this earth, to redeem us from our sinful selves. It was a cross only Jesus could bear. He walks with us even now, his precious children, calling us by name, and stands before his Father on our behalf.



On **Friday**, **April 18**th **at 7pm**, we will observe **Good Friday** with a Service of Tenebrae, a service of darkness. This solemn event includes a brief meditation, gospel readings of the crucifixion, and extinguishing candles after each reading. We will leave the sanctuary in darkness, reflecting on the great sacrifice made for us.



Then on **Sunday, April 20**th, we will celebrate Easter with two worship services. The first will be a **Sunrise Service at 8am in Memorial Garden**. This outdoor service symbolizes the dawn of a new day, akin to Jesus rising from the dead and proclaiming new life and power to his people. At **10 am**, we will hold our traditional Easter service featuring bells, our full choir, and beloved Easter hymns, as we joyfully declare that

our God lives and reigns.

We invite you to join us in worship as we commemorate the pinnacle of our Christian calendar, the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. The resurrection serves as the foundation of our faith and stands as a concrete assurance that God's words and actions are indeed truthful.

PW Birthday Offering Luncheon





As you look at each of these women's lives, you will discover how to:


- Apply biblical lessons to your own modern-day struggles.

SEEKERS Class: is beginning a new study titled *Think Like Jesus* by Randy Frazee. It is an 8-week study and will run through May 25th.


